GENERAL INFORMATION

Ahead of Time

Read this booklet and note items you want to bid on. Bring it or notes with you to the auction. The list of everything on offer is included below, with the live auction entries in bid order. Plan to arrive by 5 p.m. so that you will have plenty of time to browse and enjoy the delicious finger foods and beverages. Doors will be opening at 4:45 and the bidding begins at 5.

When You Arrive

Purchase your ticket (\$10) at the door if you have not already done so and pick up your bidder number. There will be two tables at the entrance: one for those who need both tickets and bidder numbers and those who have prepaid and need only a bidder number.

Food & Drink

A selection of tasty snacks and beverages will be offered for walk-around dining. Non-alcoholic drinks will be served, and wine & beer will be available for a donation.

Silent Auction Runs from 5:00 to 6:00 P.M.

Make your bids by writing your bidder number and the amount you bid on the bidding slip accompanying each item on display. DO NOT WRITE YOUR NAME ON THIS SLIP. The minimum raise over the previous bid is \$2. You may raise the bid on any item as often as you wish. Items will be awarded to the highest bidder.

Live Auction Begins at 6:15 P.M.

Michael Povich is graciously returning to the microphone as our auctioneer! He will auction off events and services in the order they appear in this list. Bid by holding up your bidder number until it is officially recognized.

Bidding on Multiple Winner Items

Most of the items listed for live auction are meant for multiple persons. In these cases, bidding will proceed as though for one winner, and the highest bidder may claim as many slots for that offering as desired, up to the number specified by the host. Then the next highest bidder will be offered the event or service at the price established by the winning bidder, and we will proceed until all slots are claimed or there are no other bidders. For example: The highest bid for a dinner or 6 is \$40, and the winner takes 4 seats for a total of \$160. The next highest bidder takes 2 seats for \$80, and the third highest bidder declines the opportunity. The fourth highest bidder then claims the remaining 2 seats, and the entire event goes for \$240 total.

If more than one of a particular item is being offered in the silent auction, the quantity will be noted with the description on its bidding slip.

Payment

You may pay with cash, check or credit card.

Checkout and Item Pick-up

DO NOT REMOVE ANY ITEMS FROM THE SILENT AUCTION UNTIL YOU HAVE BEEN OFFICIALLY IDENTIFIED AS THE WINNING BIDDER AND HAVE PAID AND BEEN GIVEN YOUR RECEIPT.

When you are ready to leave, present your bidder number to a cashier, who will tally your items. When you have completed the payment process, the cashier will hand you receipts for all items bought. Take these receipts back to the silent auction tables and a volunteer will help you gather your purchases.

Remember to save all receipts for events and services won so that you can collect them.

All items must be paid for and removed from the church the night of the auction unless you make special arrangements with Margaret Thurston or Peggy Strong.
